A New Future for Stone Pit 1 Sultation of Tuesday 6th November

The landfilled former chalk quarry known as Stone Pit 1 is currently being restored after many years of neglect. Owners Land Logical have renewed all the gas infrastructure to meet high environmental standards.



Although this work will not be completed until at least 2022, we have been planning for the future, including exploring the feasibility of developing community assets that respond both to Local Plan policies and priorities that have been established through the Parish Council's own Neighbourhood Planning process.

In spite of the considerable challenges that are associated with managing a landfill site, our technical assessments and planning work show that a viable scheme is capable of delivering a range of environmental, social and local economic benefits, as reflected in the draft site masterplan above.

The Proposed Development

Our vision for what we are calling 'Atlas Park' is a place for 'nature, active play and healthy living'. The key elements are:

1) Delivering a real 'heart' for Stone parish at Horns Cross. Our plan makes provision for:

A multi-GP Medical Centre, subject to confirmation of NHS funding

A convenience store to expand the local offer and meet the needs of the rapidly growing local population

A number of small retail units with offices above, suitable for 'startups', all of which will add to local employment opportunities

2) A 'sports estate', developed in partnership with Halls AFC, providing an artificial and grass football pitches for club and wider community use.

3) Some 15 acres set aside for informal recreational use by the local community between Horns Cross and Stone Village

In the longer term, post completion of site restoration, there is further scope for delivering more landscape features to encourage biodiversity value, recreational space, and off-road links.

Once the application has been submitted, it will be published on the Council's website for viewing and the opportunity to comment on the application directly as part of their decision-making process.
